

Materials/Equipment Bangle base, threads, glue, metal, scissors, rings and metal rattle. Procedure: Fold the thread four times and cut it with scissors. Then use glue at the tip of the thread and start wrapping the thread around the bangle base. After that, stick the end of the thread on the bangle with glue. Then cut the cloth in the same round shape and fix it on the round shaped pitch board with glue. Draw a design of your choice on the cloth with fabric colour. Paste the whole thing on a round metal with glue. 10. Three strand pearl necklace: Materials required: Two strands of pearl, plastic thread, scissors, tarcel, divider tool, lock Method: String the pearls in the plastic thread and make three such strings of pearl. Now, sort them according to small to big size. Arrange the three strings according to small to big size and attach divider in both sides and lock it.
