## CERTIFICATE COURSE ON JEWELLERY MAKING

### COURSE CURRICULUM

Topic in details	Day	Hours
<p><b>1. <u>Bangles:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials/Equipment</b> Bangle base, threads, glue, metal, scissors, rings and metal rattle.</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Fold the thread four times and cut it with scissors. Then use glue at the tip of the thread and start wrapping the thread around the bangle base. After that, stick the end of the thread on the bangle with glue. Finally, attach the metal rattles to the bangles with the help of the rings.</p>	1	2hrs (Theory) & 3hrs (Practical)
<p><b>2. <u>Choker:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials/Equipment</b> 5 pieces of metal lockets, golden rings, red thread, scissors, plus tool</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> At first, connect the pieces of the metal locket with the help of golden rings. Then fold the thread four times and cut it with scissors, attach it with the rings hung on both sides and the choker is ready.</p>		

  
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<p><b>3. Long Necklace:</b></p> <p><b>Equipment:</b> Big golden locket, black thread, big cc ball, rings, scissors, jhumka to be attached under the locket</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> String the jhumkas along the rings. Then cut the thread with scissors. Then insert the thread through the locket. Entwine the cc balls within the same thread. Trim properly and the long Necklace is ready.</p> <p><b>4. Stud earrings:</b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b> Base for earrings, rings, sea shells</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Fix the sea shells tightly with the rings in an organised way. Fasten all the rings hung under the earrings with a big ring.</p>	2	1hr 30mins(Theory) & 3hrs30mins(Practical)
<p><b>5. Dangle earrings:</b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b> Base for Jhumka, rings, top, balls to be attached under the jhumka</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Hang the balls under the jhumka with the rings. Then attach the top and jhumka with a ring</p> <p><b>6. Cloth Necklace:</b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b> Pitch board, cloth, glue, scissors, fabric colour, metal, sea shells.</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Cut the pitch board with scissors. Then cut a piece of cloth commensurate with the pitch board's shape and attach the cloth and the pitch board with glue. After that, use fabric colour to draw a design or a metal piece of your choice and attach them both. Fix the sea shells on the borderline of the metal.</p>	3	1hr 30mins(Theory) & 3hrs30mins(Practical)
<p><b>7. Jute Bangles:</b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b> Base for bangles, jute thread, glue, scissors</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Cut the necessary amount of jute thread and use glue on the tip of the thread around it. At last,</p>		




<p>secure the end of the thread on the bangle with glue.</p> <p><b>8. <u>Jute Necklace:</u></b></p> <p><b>Requirements:</b> Pitch board for the base, jute thread, glue, needle, scissors, thick needle to create a hole.</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Cut the pitch board according to the size of a necklace. Use glue to stick the jute thread on it. Finally, attach the metal and the thread to give it a shape of a necklace.</p>	4	1hr 30mins(Theory) & 3hrs30mins(Practical)
<p><b>9. <u>Ring:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials:</b> Base for ring, cloth, fabric colour, scissors, glue, paint brush, metal, and pitch board</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Cut the pitch board in round shape. Then cut the cloth in the same round shape and fix it on the round shaped pitch board with glue. Draw a design of your choice on the cloth with fabric colour. Paste the whole thing on a round metal with glue.</p> <p><b>10. <u>Three strand pearl necklace:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials required:</b> Two strands of pearl, plastic thread, scissors, tarcel, divider tool, lock</p> <p><b>Method:</b> String the pearls in the plastic thread and make three such strings of pearl. Now, sort them according to small to big size. Arrange the three strings according to small to big size and attach divider in both sides and lock it. Fasten the tarcel with it.</p>	5	2hrs (Theory) & 3hrs(Practical)
<p><b>11. <u>Thread Bangles:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials required:</b> Base for bangles according to sizes, glue, scissors, thread of various colours, and sea shells</p> <p><b>Method:</b> Fold the tread four times and cut it. Attach the thread on the base of the bangle with glue. Dangle the sea shells with the help of rings or glue.</p>	6	2hrs (Theory)

<p><b><u>12. Earrings and necklace of chemical beads:</u></b></p> <p><b>Materials required:</b> Chemical beads, thread, scissors, plastic thread, base metal for earrings</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Use chemical beads of different colours and sizes to string them in the tarcel. Use a base metal for earrings commensurate with the size of the necklace and dangle chemical beads in it.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">&amp; 3hrs(Practical)</p>
