  - (c) How is the 'carpe diem' theme explored in Marvell's 'To his Coy Mistress'? Answer with close reference to the text.
- 2. Explain, with reference to the context, any one of the following, in not more than  $5 \times 1 = 5$ 200 words:
  - (a) Then do folk long to go on pilgrimage, And palmers to go seeking out strange strands To distant shrines well known in Sundry lands
  - (b) We've tapers too, and at our own cost die, And we in us find the eagle and the dove.

- (a) Discuss the dramatic significance of the Banquet Scene (Act III Sc. 4) Or the Sleepwalking Scene (Act V Sc.1) in Macbeth.
- (b) With close reference to at least two of his soliloquies, analyse the character of Macbeth.
- (c) How has Marlowe conceptualised divine justice in Tamburlaine the Great?
- (d) Comment on the role of ambition in Marlowe's Tamburlaine the Great.
