- 2. Explain with reference to the context, any *two* of the following in about $200 \quad 5 \times 2 = 10$ words each:
 - (a) "A damsel with a dulcimer In a vision once I saw;

It was an Abyssinian maid"

- (b) "The anchor of my purest thoughts, the nurse, The guide, the guardian of my heart, and soul Of all my moral being."
- (c) "Beauty is truth, truth beauty, that is all Ye know on earth, and all ye need to know."
- (d) "Oh! Lift me as a wave, a leaf, a cloud! I fall upon the thorns of life! I bleed!"
